## COMPETITION INTRODUCTION

The global COVID-19 novel coronavirus pandemic has severe negative impacts on all aspects of the social life in 2020. It has rapidly spread around the world, posing enormous health, economic, environmental and social challenges to the entire human population.

As an estimated 70% of the world population will live in cities by 2050, architecture, urban design and planning against pandemic will become even more important in years to come.

But the pandemic also offers a chance to change and prepare for our future. This is the time for us to reshape the way our cities are built, maintained and lived in.

The question is: How should we shape our city for the unknown future?

Future city: Smart design for post-pandemic world is a first competition launched by Institute of Smart City and Management (ISCM), University of Economics Ho Chi Minh city (UEH) in partnership with University of Architecture Hochiminh city, Hochiminh city University of Technology, Handong Global University, Technical University of Mandalay, Blekinge Institute of Technology, Politecnico di Milano, Le Cnam, University of Melbourne. The competition is sponsored by HTE Global Co. Ltd, Handong Engineering and Construction Co. Ltd. and Korea Institute of Building Energy Technology. In this very first competition, participants are asked to look at the existing urban built environment and imagine how it should cope with the future pandemic.

Participants are free to either extend these existing areas and transform them, or propose a new design on a site of their choice.

This competition encourages participants to be bold and think outside the box. How can architecture, urban design and planning response to the resilience of city during and after pandemic outbreak.

Participants need to apply unique strategies and creative designs to tackle the disease crisis, taking technology development into account.

# COMPETITION PROGRAM

## Subject and aim of the competition

The objective of the competition is to visualize and design scenarios to shape future smart cities in which they can cope well with pandemics and other potential issues. We ask that you envision a scenario for an urban environment with an emphasis on how it will play a major role in preventing and maintaining the safety of its people during pandemics. The objective of the competition is to visualize the future urban environments and show how they change to adapt and keep their sustainability through pandemics, the new way urban activities and social interactions will take place in that new environment.

## Topic to be taken into consideration

Relevant topics that have to be taken into account for the design of the scenarios are described below. As the aim of the competition is to envision future scenarios, the proposals can be wriggled out of today's technological limits, so it is possible to imagine and use tools that do not exist nowadays; social activities can be thought accordingly.

Topic of interest for the call are the following:

Public space; Urban Transportation; Urban residential building and area; Mix-used building.

## Project area

The area of interest is the urban space and freely chosen by the participants. The recommended areas are where the social interaction activities take place vigorously or other places that have potential impacts on urban environment and its activities.

## Required materials

Participants have to upload the required materials (listed as follows) following the instruction specified in this document. The required materials have to be delivered in digital version only, within the deadlines defined by this call and following the requirements listed below.

*The uploaded material must not contain any information about the identity of the participants; the only except is made for the "identity code" of the group (given at the registered confirmation and need to be indicated on each produced document). Any failure to comply with the identity regulation will result in exclusion from the competition. The only file that must contain information about the identity of the participant is the Personal information sheet (info\_ID.xlsx) that will not be given to the jury until the end of the final evaluation phase.*

- A cityscape drawing to illustrate how the proposal fits in the surrounding built environment;
- A concept design development which highlights all aspects of the design that allow urban community fight against pandemic;
- The main points of proposed plans and sections, multiple internal and external perspectives demonstrate the spatial quality of the building as well as operational needs and accessibility requirement, especially in how the proposal can foster the community resilient in time of pandemic;
- A concept drawing to demonstrate the proposal approach to environment, energy, and sustainability in term of pandemic crisis.

## **HOW TO NAME THE REQUIRED MATERIALS**

All files submitted must be name as instruction in Material required for the admission (Mandatory), changing the “ID” wording with the “Identity code” assigned during the registration (for instance, the file SUMMARY\_ID.docx must be renamed as SUMMARY\_FCDC030, “FCDC030” is the “Identity code” given to participant along with the registered confirmation). Each delivered file must always contain the “Identity code” preceded by the symbol “\_” (underscore) at the end of the file name (e.g. SUMMARY\_FCDC030)

In case of Proposal panels (drawings), please changing the “NumberOfPanel” wording with the progressive number. ## **JURY**

The international jury will be composed by scientific experts and specialists, such as architects and designers, Smart City stakeholders, representatives of the business sector. The components of the jury will be officially formalized at the end of the evaluation procedure.

### **Evaluation criteria**

The Jury will adopt the following criteria, considering the aim and objective of the competition and the representation of the proposed scenarios:

- The ability of imagining, representing and communicating the scenarios of the smart city of the future;
- The adaptation, resilient and sustainability of the proposal against the pandemic and other potential hazards;
- Aesthetic quality of the presentation;
- Level of innovation of the proposed solutions.

### **Selecting top 3 winners**

Jury panel will produce a shortlist of 30 from all the submitted entries;  
Jury panel will select 15 competition finalists from the shortlist;  
Jury panel will evaluate the 15 finalists and select the top 3 winning projects and 10 honourable mentions.

### **Selecting sponsor favorite idea project**

Our sponsor will select 1 project from finalists that have the most standout ideas.

### **Selecting most popular project**

From the 1st of August 2020, all the finalist projects will be uploaded to ISCM community page at <https://www.facebook.com/ISCM.ueh>. On 28th of September 2020, the most liked and shared project will received the Most popular prize.

### **Closing ceremony**

The competition will end with a ranking of merit for first three projects selected by the jury panel, one project selected by our sponsors, one project selected by the community and 10 more honourable mention projects. All 15 projects will be displayed at the exhibition opening during the ceremony, and will remain in

exhibition in ISCM office, University of Economics Ho Chi Minh city from 26th September to 03rd October of 2020. The results of the competition may be presented in other contexts and locations such as exhibitions and events.

The 5 projects selected by jury panel, our sponsor and community and 10 others with honourable mention will be officially notified by email address provided during the registration procedure (the one of the group leader). The results will be published on the competition website as well.

The closing ceremony will be held in ISCM office of University of Economics Ho Chi Minh city (Address) on the morning of the 29th September 2020 (The exact time will be published on the competition website and via email to all participants).

All participants will be acknowledged with Certificates of Achievement and competition winners will get Honorable Certificates of Achievement.

The first call for application is the 1st of July 2020 and the last one is the 15th of July 2020.

Groups intended to take part to the competition have to identify a leader among the members of the group itself. The group can be composed by a single person (who will be considered the leader). The leader of the group can proceed with the online registration on the link previously mentioned. There is no registration fee. The limit number for group member is 3. Once the registration is completed, a unique “identity code” will be generated and send to the group leader via a registration confirmation email. This code must be indicated in all submitted materials to permit the identification of the group.

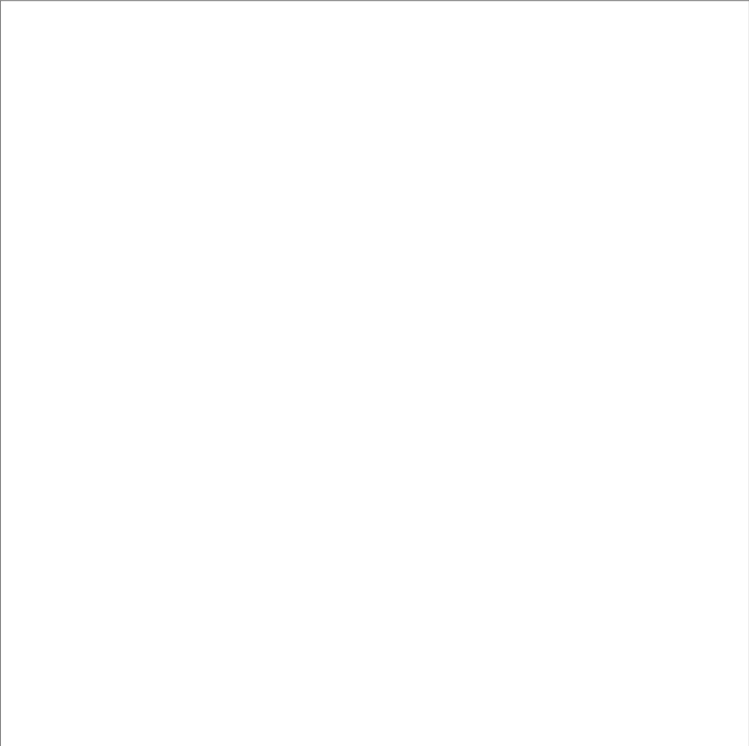
